

## The Quilter's Color Workshop

Love quilting but struggle with picking fabrics? Love color but want to learn more? End your fabric frustration. Go beyond what looks "good" to what looks "WOW". This hands-on workshop has several color and fabric selection exercises and gives you practical techniques to that you can take straight to the quilt shop.

### Supply List

#### Before class

- Cut 200 2" squares to use and share. Include EVERY color, print and texture possible
- dots, stripes, checks, flowers, solids, lights, darks - EVERY kind!

4 white poster boards approx. 28" by 22". Lined or unlined is fine.

2-3 glue sticks

1 fat quarter-size, large-scale floral print fabric with registration marks in selvage

1 picture of flowers (approx. 8-1/2" by 11"). Calendars or magazines are good sources.

Color Wheel (My favorite is Creative Color Wheel 3389)
