

Fun and Done

1 session 4 hours

This quilt uses the "sew-as -you-go" method. A quick and easy project that has all the quilting completed by the end of the project. Of course, if you are an avid quilter, there is always room for additional embellishing!

Required Pattern: Fun and Done by Jackie Vujcich

Fabric:

Main focus - 1/4 yd. (I suggest a busy print with lots of color – floral or holiday themes work well)

Coordinating fabrics - 1/4 yd each of 2 different fabrics (less busy, tonals work well)

Setting triangles - 1/4 yd

Binding 1/4 yd

Backing and batting - 20" x 40" of each

Notions:

Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget foot controller and plug)

Seam ripper, machine needles, pins,

Needle with a large eye or self-threading needle

Thread - color to match backing of the quilt (please have bobbin wound before class)

Rotary cutter (a personal cutting mat is optional), additional blades?

Ruler 6" x 24" (if you have a 6" or 6 1/2" square you may want to bring that also)

Pen

Maybe a lunch or snack as this is a longer class

Pre-class "homework": Baste your batting and backing together with your favorite method. Wind your bobbin with thread to match the backing fabric.
