Supply List – Tree Rings, modular units

- A sewing machine that you are familiar with in good working order. A free-motion foot, zig-zag foot, and straight stitch foot are essential. Please bring the manual for the machine, just in case!
- Thread in browns, black, and perhaps tans. Brown and black are the most important. I typically use Gutermann for this application, but bring what you have and the thread that works with your machine. For example, Coats & Clarks won't work in my machine.
- Small cutting mat, rotary cutter, scissors. We will be cutting circles on the mat and a "spinning" mat is nice but not required.
- Tweezers & seam ripper

Optional

- Task Light
- Seat Cushion

Sewing machine needles. I typically use a 90/14 Quilting Needle, but different machines often prefer different needles. We will be sewing through Peltex and multiple layers of fabric. I've attached a section of a needle chart for reference. If you have a thicker quilting thread, you may wish to try a topstitch needle, however, a thicker thread is not needed for this application.

Quilting	Machine quilting	75/11 and 90/14	Quilting needles feature a sharp, tapered point and are designed to stitch through thick layers and intersecting seams. Use them for piecing quilts and machine quilting the layers together.
Top-stitch	Topstitching	80/12, 90/14 and 100/16	Topstitch needles have an extra-large eye and a large groove to accommodate heavy topstitching thread or two strands of all-purpose thread. They also feature an extra-sharp point for straight, accurate stitching.
